Impact of Alcohol on Adolescents

- The average age when youth first try alcohol is 11 years for boys and 13 for girls. The average age at which Americans begin drinking regularly is 15.9 years old.
- Adolescents who begin drinking before age 15 are five times more likely to develop alcohol dependence than those who begin drinking at age 21.
- Teens who abuse alcohol can shrink their brain capacity up to 10%. An adolescent's central nervous system and brain are not fully developed and are especially sensitive to alcohol, the most commonly used drug.
- Alcohol is the leading factor as the cause of death for 15 to 24 year olds involved in automobile crashes, homicides and suicides.

Impacto del Alcohol En los Adolescentes

- La edad promedio cuando los jóvenes prueban su primer bebida alcohólica es 11 años para los varones y 13 para las mujeres. La edad promedio en la que los Americanos empiezan a beber regularmente es a los 15.9 años.
- Jóvenes que empiezan a beber alcohol antes de los 15 años tienen 5 veces más probabilidades de desarrollar problemas de alcohol que quienes lo hacen después de los 21 años.
- Adolescentes que abusan el alcohol pueden encoger su capacidad cerebral hasta un 10%. El sistema nervioso central y el cerebro de un adolescente no están completamente desarrollados y son especialmente sensibles al alcohol, la droga más comúnmente usada.
- Alcohol es el factor primordial como la causa de muerte en jóvenes de 15 a 24 años involucrados en accidentes automovilísticos, homicidios y suicidios.
